SICK BAY

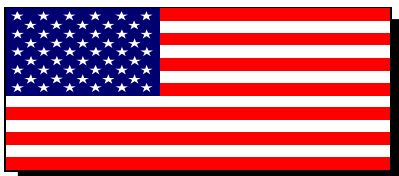
