GOLF OUTING

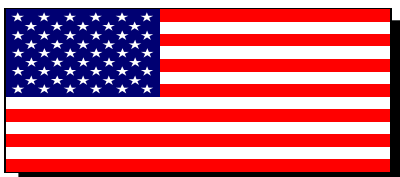
