If any member becomes aware of a sick member or spouse whom we should respond to, let **Mark Hayes** know at the above contact information.

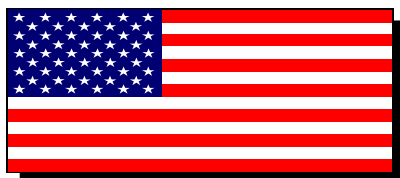
CLUB ITEMS
